

CVIT PREVIOUS CENTRAL CAMPUS REOPENING PLAN - UPDATE APRIL 26, 2021

CVIT followed the reopening guidelines as determined by the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) using their COVID-19 School Benchmarks as of August 7, 2020, as guidance. CVIT Central Campus at EAC Gila Pueblo in Globe operated on a distance learning only model, beginning August 17, 2020, until Gila County met the required benchmarks to allow hybrid (virtual and in-person) learning.

The college required face masks for all employees. "All employees will wear protective face coverings when entering campuses, in common areas located in buildings, during any interaction where there are less than six feet between people, or when walking near others. Students will be encouraged to wear face coverings." - President Haynie
